Legislation Report V.P.s.....Elaine Freeman/Ann Duran

UPDATE – SB 1160 Last month we reported on this bill which would have required every gun owner in the state to register their gun (s) annually for a fee to the State of California. The bill did not get support but was amended to read: “Expands punishment to apply if a person with immediate possession of a handgun and unexpended ammunition capable of being discharged from that handgun is not listed with the Department of Justice as the registered owner of that firearm.

“Ballot Propositions for November 2024 – There are currently 11 statewide ballot propositions that have qualified. Of those, seven are citizen initiatives and relate to pandemic prevention, the state's minimum wage, remediation for labor violations, vote requirements for new taxes, local rent control, and oil and gas well regulations. The State legislature voted to send four constitutional amendments to a statewide ballots. Detailed information on these measures will be provided along with a recommended voter position.


Sadler Scholarship Fund
