### **Legislation Report V.P.s.....Elaine Freeman/Ann Duran**

**California Lowers Supermajority Requirement to 55% for Local Special Taxes to Fund Housing Amendment is on the ballot for the November 5th election.**

A **"YES"** vote supports lowering the vote threshold from 66.67% to 55% for local special taxes and bond measures to fund housing projects and public infrastructure.

A **"NO"** vote opposes lowering the vote threshold from 66.67% to 55% for local special taxes and bond measures to fund housing projects and public infrastructure.

#### **Who supports and opposes the amendment?**

The amendment gets **endorsements** from the California Democratic Party.

The amendment is **opposed** by the California Association of

Realtors, California Chamber of Commerce, California Taxpayer Association, Howard Jarvis Taxpayers Association; and **Dr. Gary Galles**, economics professor at Pepperdine University: "ACA 1 would sharply lower Proposition 13's two-thirds voter threshold to

55% for local special taxes to fund 'infrastructure' so vaguely defined that virtually anything could qualify. It would open the door to massive new tax hikes to give Sacramento politicians what they want from property tax-payers without giving them their money's worth in return."
